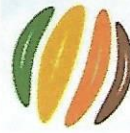
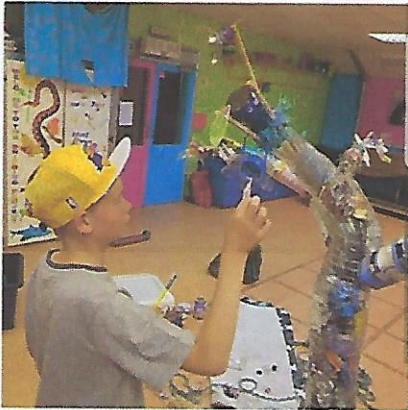


The Bridging Project

The Bridging Project is a targeted weekly youth work programme for young people aged 12 - 25 with Special Educational Needs or Disabilities (SEND), supported by a small team of peer leaders from our leadership programme as well as youth workers and volunteers. Through this project young people are able to meet new people from their local community, develop social skills, and provide them with valuable practical learning opportunities and experiences that will help them later on in life.

The Bridging Project runs on a Tuesday evenings 6:30 - 9pm from Mere Youth Centre. We also provide transport from Tisbury and surrounding villages. Our programme provides a variety of developmental activities including: arts & crafts, cooking, sports & games, practical woodwork, gardening and lots more. Young people are also supported to gain accreditation and many go on to access other youth work opportunities provided by the charity.

This is what young people attending the project said:

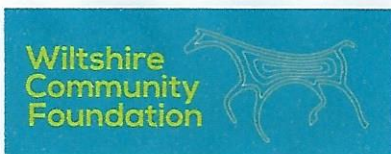
'I made new friends, learnt how to cook and become more confident' (Male aged 19)
